### **Discussion of Gym Feasibility Study**

A wide ranging discussion was held discussing the options outlined in the study.

Ms Lynn said the option of the Partnership running the Gym was not one the Partnership was interested in. The main options were a separate organisation running the Gym and affiliated to the Centre or the Management Committee being in overall charge. If the Centre ran the Gym it would get all the revenue but if there was a separate organisation the Centre would only receive rent and affiliation fees.

It seemed possible we could be getting a grant of £10,000 and/or £6,000 from the Borough.

It was suggested that instead of the snooker room we could start in the pool room, it was larger than some present remembered and had some natural light, unlike the snooker room. There would be room for 3 or 4 pieces of CV equipment and some weights. While there was only one plug point some of any original grant could be used to address that issue

A trip to Wheatley Hill Community Gym would be arranged, by Ms Lynn, probably for Friday 11th November, to see how they had managed their transformation and how they managed their Gym.
