It was suggested that we could approach the Parish Council for funding in lieu of the money they would usually spend on the Summer Splash Scheme as that scheme would not run this year.

Mr Ferguson suggested that a sub-committee be formed to make decisions as needed when the electrical work was being done. It was decided that it should consist of him, Mrs Drew, Ms Bellingham, Mrs Liddle and Miss Weir

Mr Ferguson said he expected the Play area equipment to be installed by the end of April.
