1 WEST CORNFORTH COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

Members were advised that the meeting had been called to consider difficulties being experienced by West Cornforth Community Association. Reference was made to certain short term problems requiring urgent action together with longer term aims to secure a sustainable community association capable of managing community facilities in the village to meet the need of all age ranges. The issues of life long learning and opportunities for building adult skills were examined.

It was noted that the Parish Council would need to work in partnership with community and enabling groups to realise the aim of securing a sustainable community association capable of managing community facilities in the village.
