Minutes of a meeting of the Recreation and Amenities Committee held at Cornforth Community Centre on Monday 19th July 2004, at 7.00 p.m.

1 MINUTES

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 24th May 2004 were confirmed as a correct record.

2 INSPECTION OF COMMUNITY PARKS

Members inspected Cornforth Community Park and Stobb Cross Community Park sites prior to the commencement of the meeting. Consideration was then given to matters arising from the inspections.

RECOMMENDED: That the following works be carried out:

Stobb Cross Community Park

- a) Entrance post to be repaired.
- b) Additional planting be provided behind dry stone walling and to fenced area to left of entrance.
- c) Metal gate and gate posts to be painted.
- d) Bushes to be cut in the vicinity of style and dog waste bin.
- e) Hedge line to rear of site to be flailed.
- f) Fallen tree to be removed.
- g) Litter bin to be provided outside park when next phase of litter bin provision in the village is determined.
- h) Litter to be removed in accordance with existing contract.

Cornforth Community Park

- a) Remedial works to be undertaken to safety surfacing in toddlers play area.
- b) Equipment and perimeter fencing at toddlers and junior play areas to be repainted.
- c) Provision be made in 2005/06 for perimeter fencing of the community park to be repainted.
- d) Graffiti on climbing frame in junior play area to be removed.
- e) Graffiti on tarmac cycle track to be removed.
- f) Weeds to be removed from block paved areas.
- g) Litter to be removed in accordance with existing contract.
- h) Two litter bins to be replaced when next phase of litter bin provision in the village is determined.
