1 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

2 MULTI - AGENCY RESPONSE TO ANTI - SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR - WEST CORNFORTH.

Members were reminded that at the last Parish Council Meeting the Chairman commented on proceedings at a public meeting that had been held in the Community Centre to discuss the problem of anti-social behaviour in the village.

It was reported that since that public meeting, further meetings of interested parties had been held to establish a multi - agency response to anti-social behaviour in West Cornforth. This would lead to the development of an action plan based on the Home Office National Intelligence Model used by the Police in their planning and delivery of services. Members were informed of initial progress that had been made in developing such a plan.

Particular reference was made to a meeting with young people from the village attended by representatives of Durham Constabulary, the Youth Engagement Service and The Cornforth Partnership at which concerns of young people and ideas for the way forward were expressed.

RESOLVED: That the information be received and arrangements be made for the Council Chairman to meet with the Chairman of The Cornforth Partnership and Mr. T. Dodds of Cornforth Community Centre to discuss youth provision in the village.
