1 MINUTES

3 GROUPS AND ORGANISATIONS WITHIN WEST CORNFORTH - ACTIVITIES PROGRAMME

A schedule was circulated to Members for information.

4 MOBILE MOVIES PROJECT - SEDGEFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL

It was reported that the first Mobile Movies evening at West Cornforth Community Centre on Thursday 14th October had featured Shrek II and had attracted an audience of 42. Members considered this a promising start to the venture.

5 REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

The Clerk reported that the Police and officers of the Highway Authority had met with Parish/ Town Clerks to examine applications for road closures required on Remembrance Sunday. In respect of Cornforth Parish Council its application for a road closure order effective from 10.45a.m. - 11.15a.m. on Sunday 14th November 2004 was approved.

Appropriate arrangements were to be made for temporary road closure notices to be erected by a traffic management company prior to the event in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1980.
